Regulations: future situation

- European Directive 2006/87/CE (starting from 30.12.08)
- New Rina Rules for Inland navigation (in force from the end of 2008)
- Security Regulation for inland navigation and for the lagoon of Venice
- Italian Ministry of Transport Directives
- Rules on calculation of Tonnage

Authorized Shipyards for vessel construction

- For maritime navigation
- For inland navigation

Surveys recognized societies and bodies

- commercial boats: Ministry of Transport, Rina, Bureau Veritas, Germanischer Lloyd's, ABS
- pleasure boats: Rina, Udicer, Giordano, ANCCP, DNV, Quality & Security, I.Q.M.

Navigation in mixed waters

- at the moment only lagoon of Venice
- in the future: the maritime zone between Ravenna and Trieste
- several authorities and a lot of different Regulations

Differences in Regulations between maritime and inland navigation

- different criteria on Gross Tonnage calculation
- crew composition
- Security Regulation
- Technical requirements of Rules for inland navigation are often incomplete

Kinds of commercial navigation:

- Lakes of northern Italy and Lagoon of Venice: a lot of passenger boats, mostly between 10-15 meters with 20-100 pax
- River Po: few cargo vessels, numerous old dredgers and working pontoons, not many touristic fluvial boats (some passenger boats in Mantova, Ferrara and on the delta) and houseboats.
- Others Lakes and rivers: small commercial activity

Bureau and procedures for boats registration

- Provincial Administration, Port Inspectorate, Council, ecc...
- Statement of beginning and end of construction
- Emission of final check report
- Application for registration

Pleasure Navigation - Regulations in force

- Rina pleasure craft Rules
- European Directive 94/25/EC
- Italian law on pleasure navigation (8 July 2003, No. 172)

Pleasure navigation:

- 100.000 approx. pleasure boats (only 20.000 registered)
- most < 7.5 m.
- boats under 10 meters do not need periodical surveys
